Upon considering the Application to Retain and Employ Sills Cummis & Gross P.C. as

Attorneys for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Progressive Acute Care, LLC., et

al., Nunc Pro Tunc to June 21, 2016, including the Affidavit of Andrew H. Sherman in support

thereof (collectively, the "Application") [ECF #137], filed June 30, 2016 by the Official

Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Progressive Acute Care, LLC, et al. (the "Committee"),

including a request for *ex parte* relief on an interim basis;

And considering the Court has jurisdiction to consider the Application in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and this being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2);

And considering the Court's Interim Order [ECF #154] granting the Application on an interim basis and the Notice of Hearing filed and served regarding the Application [ECF #157];

And considering the substance of the Application, its supporting materials, the lack of any objection to the Application after due notice and opportunity for an objection; and it appearing that (i) the proposed employment of Sills as attorneys for the Committee is in the best interest of the Committee and the bankruptcy estates, (ii) Sills does not represent any entity having an adverse interest in connection with the case, as required by 11 U.S.C. § 1103(b), and Sills and its Members, Of Counsel, and Associates do not represent or hold any interest adverse to the Committee or the bankruptcy estates and are disinterested under 11 U.S.C. § 101(14), and (iii) the Application and materials are in compliance with the applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code and the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; and after due deliberation thereon; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor:

It is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Application is **GRANTED**.

The Committee is authorized to retain and employ Sills as its attorneys 11 U.S.C.
 § 1103 an Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2014 *nunc pro tunc* to June 21, 2016 on the terms set forth in the Application and affidavit of Andrew H. Sherman in support.

3. Sills shall be compensated for its services and reimbursed for any related expenses in accordance 11 U.S.C. §§ 328, 330, and 331, the applicable provisions of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Local Bankruptcy Rules for the Western District of Louisiana, and any orders of this Court.
