## DEBTORS' MOTION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER AUTHORIZING DEBTORS TO SELL CERTAIN OIL AND GAS ASSETS FREE AND CLEAR OF ALL LIENS, CLAIMS, AND ENCUMBRANCES

The above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "<u>Debtors</u>") respectfully state as follows in support of this motion (the "<u>Motion</u>").

## **Relief Requested**

The Debtors seek entry of an order, substantially in the form attached hereto as
 <u>Exhibit A</u>, authorizing the sale of certain of their Wells (as defined below) in Oil and Gas
 Auctions (as defined below) or privately-negotiated sales pursuant to sections 363(b) and (c) of

title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

### **Jurisdiction and Venue**

2. The United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "<u>Court</u>") has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the *Amended Standing Order of Reference from the United States District Court for the District of Delaware*,

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dated February 29, 2012. This matter is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2). The Debtors confirm their consent, pursuant to rule 9013-1(f) of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Local Rules"), to the entry of a final order by the Court in connection with this motion to the extent that it is later determined that the Court, absent consent of the parties, cannot enter final orders or judgments in connection herewith consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution.

3. Venue is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.

The statutory basis for the relief requested herein is section 363 of the Bankruptcy
 Code.

### **Background**

5. On September 16, 2015 (the "<u>Petition Date</u>"), each of the Debtors filed a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. The Debtors are operating their businesses and managing their properties as debtors in possession pursuant to sections 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code. On September 18, 2015, the Court entered an order [Docket No. 70] authorizing joint administration and procedural consolidation of these chapter 11 cases pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 1015(b). On September 30, 2015, the United States Trustee for the District of Delaware (the "<u>U.S. Trustee</u>") appointed an official committee of unsecured creditors pursuant to section 1102 of the Bankruptcy Code.

6. A description of the Debtors' businesses and the reasons for commencing the chapter 11 cases is set forth in the *Declaration of Philip Cook in Support of Chapter 11 Petitions and First Day Motions* [Docket No. 2].

#### **Oil and Gas Auctions and the Wells**

7. From time to time, the Debtors participate in auctions for oil and gas properties (the "<u>Oil and Gas Auctions</u>") in which the Debtors sell rights in certain of their properties. Oil and Gas Auctions are conducted by a number of specialized clearinghouses and are commonly utilized in the exploration and production industry for matching willing sellers looking to dispose of properties with willing buyers seeking to acquire oil and gas properties. Importantly, transactions conducted through Oil and Gas Auctions typically provide a clean break for the seller from liabilities associated with the property with the buyer typically assuming all liabilities arising from a purchased property.

8. As it relates to the Debtors, Oil and Gas Auctions bring out prospective buyers willing to take on the risks associated with properties that do not fit the Debtors' targeted profile for their exploration, drilling, and production goals. The Debtors have historically worked with The Oil and Gas Clearinghouse ("<u>OGAC</u>") as the clearinghouse for auctioning the Debtors' assets. OGAC was founded in 1992 with a focus on providing clearinghouse services for the oil and gas industry. Since its inception, OGAC has brokered more than 32,000 transactions and become the industry leader in marketing and auctioning oil and gas interests, like the Wells. The Debtors and their predecessors have utilized OGAC to sell over \$600 million in properties over the past twenty years. OGAC is holding an Oil and Gas Auction on March 9, 2016.

9. In evaluating their businesses and properties in the recent months, the Debtors have identified approximately 1,262 wells and related property and interests (collectively, the "<u>Wells</u>") that do not fit their business model. The complete list of Wells is attached hereto as <u>**Exhibit B**</u>. Many of the Wells are old with limited going-forward production capability. The aggregate PV9 reserve value for the Wells is approximately \$16.5 million. Approximately 571

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of the Wells are subject to mortgages and are valued by the Debtors at less than \$1 million each. Approximately 691 of the Wells, on the other hand, are unmortgaged and/or are valued by the Debtors at more than \$1 million each. The proceeds from the sale of any Well not subject to a mortgage will be held separately from the Debtors' operating cash. The Debtors seek to put the Wells up for auction at OGAC's March 9, 2016 auction or otherwise consummate private sales for the Wells.

10. Participation in Oil and Gas Auctions is commonplace both for the Debtors and for their industry generally. Accordingly, the Debtors submit that selling the Wells in the OGAC Oil and Gas Auction to take place on March 9, 2016 is an ordinary course transaction and the Court's approval is not required. Out of an abundance of caution, however, the Debtors seek authority to sell the Wells in the event such a sale is deemed to be anything other than in the ordinary course, as set forth herein. Importantly, the Debtors believe that the OGAC Oil and Gas Auction is the most appropriate forum to maximize value and the proceeds obtained from selling the Wells. Buyers from across the industry will be participating in the auction and ready and willing to purchase assets like the Wells, creating an optimal environment for maximizing value that a Court-supervised auction is unlikely to replicate.

11. In addition to the OGAC Oil and Gas Auction, and as an alternative to the OGAC Oil and Gas Auction, the Debtors seek authority to negotiate and consummate private sales of the Wells.<sup>2</sup> While the Debtors anticipate selling the vast majority of the Wells through the OGAC Oil and Gas Auction, the Debtors may be unable to sell some Wells through the auction. In that instance, the Debtors could obtain value in a private sale. Some of these private sales will be

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conducted on the same terms as sales conducted through an Oil and Gas Auction; the Wells will be sold "as is" with the buyer assuming all related liabilities. Others may be consummated as a sale under section 363 of the Bankruptcy Code, with the buyer acquiring the Wells free and clear of all claims, liens, and interests. Obtaining authority now to pursue these sales will ensure that the Debtors are able to maximize the value of the Wells and minimize transaction costs to their estates.

12. The Debtors have discussed participating in the OGAC Oil and Gas Auction and, as an alternative, consummating private sales of the Wells with the agents under the Debtors' first lien credit facility and second lien credit facility. Neither of those parties has raised any objection to the relief requested herein.

#### **Basis for Relief**

13. Section 363(c) of the Bankruptcy Code provides that a debtor "may enter into transactions, including the sale or lease of property of the estate, in the ordinary course of business, without notice or a hearing, and may use property of the estate in the ordinary course of business without notice or a hearing." 11 U.S.C. § 363(c)(1). A transaction is in the ordinary course of business if it is "of the sort commonly undertaken by companies in [the debtor's] industry" and it does not subject a hypothetical creditor "to economic risk of a nature different from those he accepted when he decided to extend credit." *In re Roth Am., Inc.*, 975 F.2d 949, 952–53 (3d Cir, 1992).

14. Selling the Wells in Oil and Gas Auctions or through private sales is in the ordinary course of the Debtors' business. The Debtors and similar companies in the industry often dispose of oil and gas properties that are not fit for their particular businesses through Oil and Gas Auctions and private transactions. Additionally, selling the Wells will not expose any

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creditors to any incremental economic risk beyond that which they accepted in dealing with the Debtors prepetition. The Debtors have long participated in Oil and Gas Auctions, particularly with OGAC, and creditors with any knowledge of the exploration and production industry would have been aware of the prevalence of Oil and Gas Auctions as a means of disposing of oil and gas properties. The same goes for privately-negotiated well sales. As a result, the Debtors respectfully submit that the Court should approve the sale of the Wells in the Oil and Gas Auctions or through private sales as an ordinary course transaction under section 363(c)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code.

15. The Debtors believe that selling the Wells in the Oil and Gas Auctions or through private sales (as the Debtors routinely do in the operation of their businesses) is in the ordinary course of business. If, however, the sale were deemed to occur outside the ordinary course of business, section 363(b) of the Bankruptcy Code provides that a debtor, "after notice and a hearing, may use, sell, or lease, other than in the ordinary course of business, property of the estate." 11 U.S.C. § 363(b)(1). In the Third Circuit, courts have authorized transactions outside the ordinary course of business when the transaction has a sound business purpose and is proposed in good faith. *See In re Martin*, 91 F.3d 389, 395 (3d Cir. 1996); *In re Montgomery Ward Holding Corp.*, 242 B.R. 147, 153 (D. Del. 1999); *In re Delaware & Hudson Ry. Co.*, 124 B.R. 169, 176 (D. Del. 1991); *In re Exaeris, Inc.*, 380 B.R. 741, 744 (Bankr. D. Del. 2008).

16. The Court may approve selling the Wells in the Oil and Gas Auctions or through private sales under section 363(b) of the Bankruptcy Code. First, the Debtors have a sound business purpose for proposing the sale. As stated above, the Wells are unfit for the Debtors' business model and, therefore, are worth little (or nothing) to the Debtors' enterprise. Selling the Wells, though, will reduce these properties to cash and, in the vast majority of cases, relieve the

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Debtors and their estates from all liabilities associated with the Wells—a boon to the Debtors' creditors, as well as the Debtors themselves. Second, the Debtors have proposed these sales in good faith and in an exercise of their sound business judgment. The Oil and Gas Auction, to be performed by OGAC, will generate the highest and best prices for the Wells. OGAC, a leading independent marketer and auctioneer of oil and gas properties, markets the Wells to promote robust participation from all likely buyers of the Wells. As stated above, OGAC has successfully marketed and auctioned the Debtors' oil and gas assets for two decades, proving to be the best venue to market the Wells—more so than a Court-supervised auction process, which could deter participation by many of those in the industry who are unfamiliar with the bankruptcy process. And to the extent that a private sale becomes desirable, the marketing undertaken in the OGAC Oil and Gas Auction will have borne out the value of that private sale. Therefore, a separate, court-supervised marketing and auction process is not necessary.

17. Thus, the Debtors submit that selling the Wells in the Oil and Gas Auctions should be approved under section 363(b) of the Bankruptcy Code.

#### <u>Notice</u>

18. The Debtors will provide notice of this motion to: (a) the Office of the U.S. Trustee for the District of Delaware; (b) the Committee; (c) the holders of the 50 largest unsecured claims against the Debtors (on a consolidated basis); (d) the agent under the Debtors' first lien credit facility; (e) counsel to the agent under the Debtors' first lien credit facility; (f) the agent under the Debtors' second lien credit facility; (g) counsel to the agent under the Debtors' second lien credit facility; (h) the indenture trustee under the Debtors' 9.75% senior notes due 2020; (i) counsel to certain majority holders of the existing common stock of the Debtors; (j) holders of the existing preferred stock of the Debtors; (k) counsel to holders of the existing

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preferred stock of the Debtors; (1) the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Delaware; (m) the Internal Revenue Service; (n) the United States Securities and Exchange Commission; (o) the Environmental Protection Agency and similar state environmental agencies for states in which the Debtors conduct business; (p) the state attorneys general for states in which the Debtors conduct business; (q) all holders of royalty and other interests relating to the Wells; and (r) those parties requesting notice pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2002. The Debtors submit that, in light of the nature of the relief requested, no other or further notice need be given.

### No Prior Request

19. No prior request for the relief sought in this motion has been made to this or any other court.

## ORDER AUTHORIZING DEBTORS TO SELL CERTAIN OIL AND GAS ASSETS FREE AND CLEAR OF ALL LIENS, CLAIMS, AND ENCUMBRANCES

Upon the motion (the "<u>Motion</u>")<sup>2</sup> of the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "<u>Debtors</u>"), for entry of an order (this "<u>Order</u>") authorizing the Debtors to sell the Wells in the Oil and Gas Auctions or in private sales under section 363 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "<u>Bankruptcy Code</u>"), all as set forth in the Motion, free and clear of all liens, claims, and encumbrances; and the Court having found that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and the Court having found that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and the Court having found that venue of this proceeding and the motion in this district is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and the Court having found that the relief requested in the motion is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates, their creditors, and other parties in interest; and the Court having found that the Debtors provided good and sufficient notice of the motion and the opportunity for a hearing on the motion under the circumstances, including to the the agents under the Debtor's

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first lien credit facility and second lien credit facility; and the Court having reviewed the motion and having heard the statements in support of the relief requested therein at a hearing before the Court (the "<u>Hearing</u>"); and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the motion and at the Hearing establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and upon all of the proceedings had before the Court; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is granted as set forth herein.

2. The Debtors are authorized to offer the Wells for sale in any Oil and Gas Auction and to enter into and perform under any agreements or other documentation necessary to consummate any sale of a Well, regardless of whether such sale results from an Oil and Gas Auction.

3. Any sale of a Well conducted pursuant to an Oil and Gas Auction or a private sale on the terms set forth in this Order shall, for all purposes, be deemed to have been negotiated and consummated at arm's length without collusion or fraud and in good faith within the meaning of section 363(m) of the Bankruptcy Code. In connection with any such sale of a Well, the purchaser thereof shall, for all purposes, be deemed not to be an "insider" of the Debtors (as such term is defined in section 101(31) of the Bankruptcy Code) and shall be deemed to have: (a) recognized that the Debtors were free to deal with any other party interested in acquiring the Wells; (b) complied with the requirements imposed by the Debtors with regard to any purchase of the Wells; (c) satisfied fully all requirements for purposes of ensuring the sale of the Wells was fully proper and sufficient, and (d) not violated section 363(n) of the Bankruptcy Code by any action or inaction. As a result of the foregoing, the purchaser of any of the Wells at an Oil and Gas Auction or through a private sale shall, for all purposes, be deemed a "good faith

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purchaser" within the meaning of section 363(m) of the Bankruptcy Code, and as such, shall be entitled to all of the protections afforded thereby, including that the sale shall not be invalidated in the event this Order or any portion thereof is reversed or modified on appeal, and such purchaser otherwise shall, for all purposes, be deemed to have proceeded in good faith in all respects in connection with the sale specifically and these chapter 11 cases generally.

4. Except as expressly provided in the terms set forth in any applicable sale agreement or by this Order, pursuant to sections 105, 363, and 365 of the Bankruptcy Code, upon the consummation of the sale of any Well, whether pursuant to an Oil and Gas Auction or a private sale, neither the purchaser nor its respective successors and assigns shall have any liability for any competing lien, claim, encumbrance, or interest, except for any specifically identified liens and any expressly identified assumed liabilities set forth in any proposed purchase and sale agreement between the Debtors and any purchaser, and such sale shall be free and clear of all liens, claims, encumbrances, and interests, whether known or unknown as of the date of such consummation, now existing or hereafter arising, whether fixed or contingent, prepetition or post-petition, whether as a successor, vicariously, or otherwise, of any kind, nature, or character whatsoever, including for any claims arising under, without limitation: (a) any labor or employment agreements; (b) all mortgages, deeds of trust, and security interests; (c) any intercompany loans and receivables between the Debtors and any non-Debtor affiliate; (d) any pension, welfare, compensation, or other employee benefit plans, agreements, practices, and programs, including, without limitation, any pension plan of any Debtor, any affiliate of any Debtor, or any member of the Debtors' "control group;" (e) any other employee, worker's compensation, occupational disease, or unemployment or temporary disability related claim, including, without limitation, claims that might otherwise arise under or pursuant to (i) the

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Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as amended, (ii) the Fair Labor Standards Act, (iii) Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, (iv) the Federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973, (v) the National Labor Relations Act, (vi) the Age Discrimination and Employee Act of 1967 and Age Discrimination in Employment Act, as amended, (vii) the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, (viii) the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985, (ix) state discrimination laws, (x) state unemployment compensation laws or any other similar state laws, (xi) the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C §§ 2101 et. seq., or (xii) any other state or federal benefits or claims relating to any employment with the Debtors or any of their predecessors; (f) claims arising under any environmental, health and safety laws with respect to any assets owned or operated by Debtors or any corporate predecessor at any time prior to the Closing Date and any liabilities of the Debtors other than the Assumed Liabilities; (g) any bulk sales or similar law; (h) any tax statutes or ordinances, including, without limitation, the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended; (i) any and all claims arising out of violations, or other non-compliance with any law(s), regulation(s), standard(s), guideline(s), enforcement order(s), or any other authority or requirement enforced by, or under the supervision of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration; (j) any theories of successor liability or causes of action related thereto; (k) any unpaid royalties or similar interests arising before the consummation of the sale; and (1) any liens, claims, or encumbrances imposed or chargeable under any financing, cash collateral, or other order of the Court, which otherwise touches or concerns the Wells that are sold a purchaser.

5. Except as expressly provided in the terms set forth in any applicable sale agreement or by this Order, effective upon the consummation of the sale of a Well, all persons and entities, including, but not limited to, all debt security holders, equity security holders,

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governmental, tax, and regulatory authorities, lenders, vendors, suppliers, employees, trade creditors, litigation claimants, holders of preferential purchase rights, and other persons holding claims or interests against or in the Debtors or the Debtors' interests in such Well (whether known or unknown, legal or equitable, matured or unmatured, contingent or noncontingent, liquidated or unliquidated, asserted or unasserted, whether arising prior to or subsequent to the commencement of these chapter 11 cases, whether imposed by agreement, understanding, law, equity or otherwise), shall be and hereby are forever barred, estopped and permanently enjoined from asserting, prosecuting, or otherwise pursuing such claims and interests against the purchaser of the Well or any of its respective affiliates, agents, advisors, representatives, officers, controlling persons, successors and assigns, the Well, or the interests of the Debtors or the purchaser in such Well, including, without limitation, taking any of the following actions with respect to any such claim or interest:

- a. commencing or continuing in any manner any action or other proceeding against the purchaser or their respective affiliates, agents, advisors, representatives, officers, controlling persons, successors, assigns, assets, or properties, including the Well;
- b. enforcing, attaching, collecting, or recovering in any manner any judgment, award, decree, or order against the purchaser or any of their respective affiliates, agents, advisors, representatives, officers, controlling persons, successors, assigns, assets, or properties, including the Well;
- c. creating, perfecting, or enforcing any liens, claims, encumbrances, or other interests against the purchaser or their respective affiliates, agents, advisors, representatives, officers, controlling persons, successors, assigns, assets, or properties, including the Well;
- d. asserting a claim as a setoff, right of subrogation, or recoupment of any kind against any obligation due the purchaser or its affiliates, agents, advisors, representatives, officers, controlling persons, successors, or assigns; or
- e. commencing or continuing any action in any manner or place that does not comply, or is inconsistent, with the provisions of this Order or the agreements or actions contemplated or taken in respect thereof.

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6. All persons are hereby enjoined from taking any action that would interfere with or adversely affect the ability of the Debtors to transfer the Wells in accordance with the terms of any applicable purchase and sale agreement and this Order. Following the consummation of the sale of any Well, no holder of any claim or interest (including as such term is used in section 363(f) of the Bankruptcy Code) against the Debtors shall interfere with the purchaser's title to or use and enjoyment of such Wells, subject to the terms of any applicable purchase agreement for such Wells.

7. Notice of the Motion as provided therein shall be deemed good and sufficient and the requirements of the Local Rules are satisfied by such notice.

8. Notwithstanding the possible applicability of Bankruptcy Rules 6004(h), 7062, 9014 or otherwise, the terms and conditions of this Order are immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

9. The Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted in this Order in accordance with the motion.

10. This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Order.
