**NOTICE OF FILING OF AMENDED STATEMENT OF

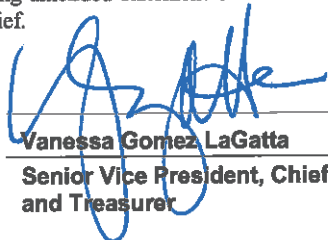
