**NOTICE OF (I) OCCURRENCE OF EFFECTIVE DATE OF PLAN; (II) SUPPLEMENTAL ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIMS BAR DATE; (III) PROFESSIONAL FEE CLAIMS BAR DATE; AND (IV) BAR DATE FOR PROOFS OF CLAIM RELATING TO EXECUTORY CONTRACTS REJECTED PURSUANT TO PLAN**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on August 24, 2017, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of New York entered an Order (the “Confirmation Order”) [Docket No. 631] in the chapter 11 cases of Long Beach Medical Center (“LBMC”) and Long Beach Memorial Nursing Home, Inc. d/b/a The Komanoff Center for Geriatric and Rehabilitative Medicine (“Komanoff”), as Debtors and Debtors-in-Possession (collectively, the “Debtors”), confirming the *First Amended Joint Plan of Liquidation Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code of Long Beach Medical Center, et al.*, dated June 26, 2017 [Docket No. 606] (the “Plan”).<sup>2</sup> The Plan, the Confirmation Order and this Notice may be viewed and downloaded free of charge on the Debtors’ case website: <http://cases.gcginc.com/lob>.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that all conditions precedent to the Effective Date of the Plan have been satisfied, and that the Effective Date occurred on October 3, 2017.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that, pursuant to section 5.7 of the Plan and paragraph 4 of the Confirmation Order, Lori Lapin Jones, Esq. has been appointed as Plan Administrator.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that, pursuant to section 2.2 of the Plan and paragraph 39 of the Confirmation Order, except as provided otherwise in the Plan for (1) Professional Persons requesting compensation or reimbursement for Professional Fee Claims, and (2) U.S. Trustee Fees, requests for payment of Administrative Claims, for which a Bar Date to file such Administrative Claim was not previously established, must be filed with the Debtors' claims agent, GCG, LLC, **by no later than December 4, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time)** (the "Administrative Bar Date") in the following manner and at the following locations (collectively, the "Claims Processing Center"):

Administrative Claims will be deemed filed only when actually received by GCG, LLC on or before the Administrative Bar Date. Administrative Claims must conform substantially to the Administrative Claim Form available on the Debtors' case website: <http://cases.gcginc.com/lob>. Administrative Claims must (i) be signed, (ii) include supporting documentation (if voluminous, attach a summary) or an explanation as to why documentation is not available, (iii) be in the English language; and (iv) be denominated in lawful United States currency. Administrative Claims must specify by name and case number the Debtor against which the claim is filed; and if the holder asserts a claim against more than one Debtor or has claims against different Debtors, a separate proof of claim form must be filed with respect to each Debtor. Administrative Claims sent by facsimile, telecopy or electronic mail transmission will not be accepted. **Any such Administrative Claims that are not timely filed shall be forever barred from assertion against the Debtors or their property.**

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that, pursuant to section 2.4 of the Plan and paragraph 40 of the Confirmation Order, all final applications for payment of Professional Fee Claims for the period through and including the Confirmation Date shall be filed with the Court and served on the Plan Administrator and the other parties entitled to notice pursuant to the *Interim Compensation and Reimbursement Procedures Order* [Docket No. 93] **by no later than December 4, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time)**. Applications that are not timely filed will not be considered by the Court.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that, pursuant to section 8.3 of the Plan and paragraph 20 of the Confirmation Order, Claims against the Debtors arising in connection with Executory Contracts rejected pursuant to the Plan (each a “Rejection Damages Claim”) must be filed with the Debtors’ claims agent, GCG, LLC, **by no later than November 20, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time)** (the “Rejection Damages Bar Date”) in the following manner and at the appropriate Claims Processing Center:
